When Maryanne first came to the school in 2003 there were around 900 students We heard about the joy and opportunity given to two young handicapped refuge girls from our donation of two laptops, the history of and the way the Flexischool operates and the lifechanging impact on those students, the quality of her staff and commitment to their students and some interesting demographics including the number of migrants and refugees, 47 different languages for those for whom English is their second language (ESL) and catering for other special needs students.

Maryanne has offered to come back with her head of Migrant and Refugee studies to give us details of the way the young girls who received the laptops are learning as well the other migrant and refugee students.
